This ensures you don't miss any important info and lightens the load for your Team Managers as most of the answers to your questions will be housed in TeamApp.

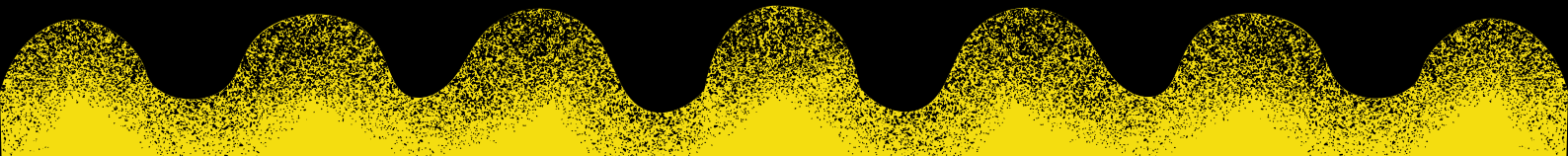


SPONSOR SPOTLIGHT
