FINALS FEVER & LIGHTNING PREM AHEAD

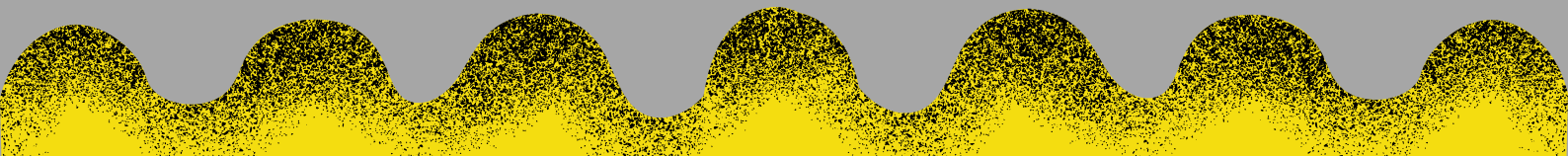
Sunshine on Sunday wasn't just good for spirits — it shone a spotlight on several teams locking in finals berths.

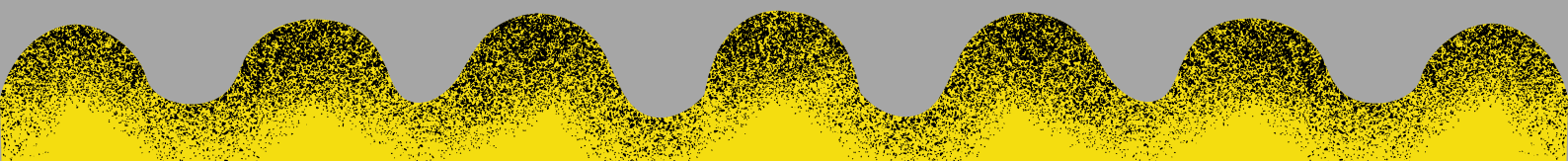


EarthLift Excavations:

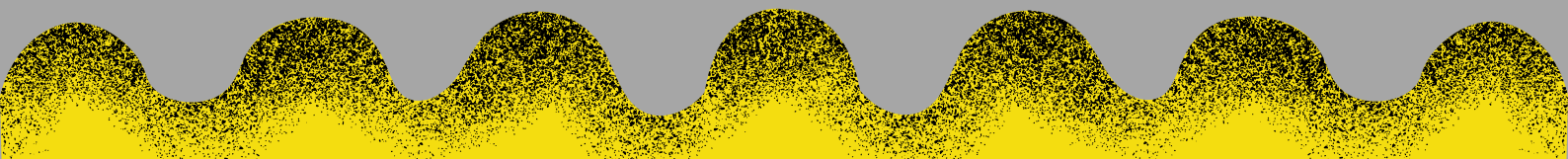
